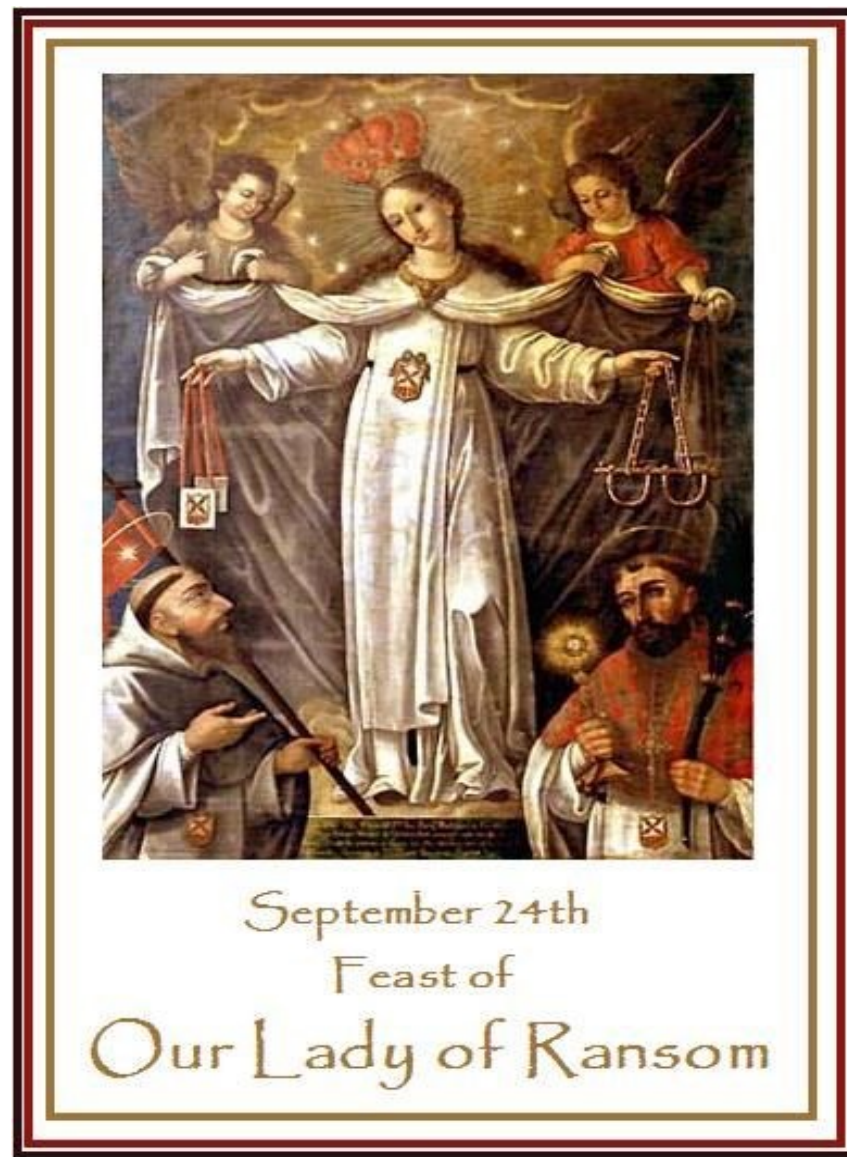

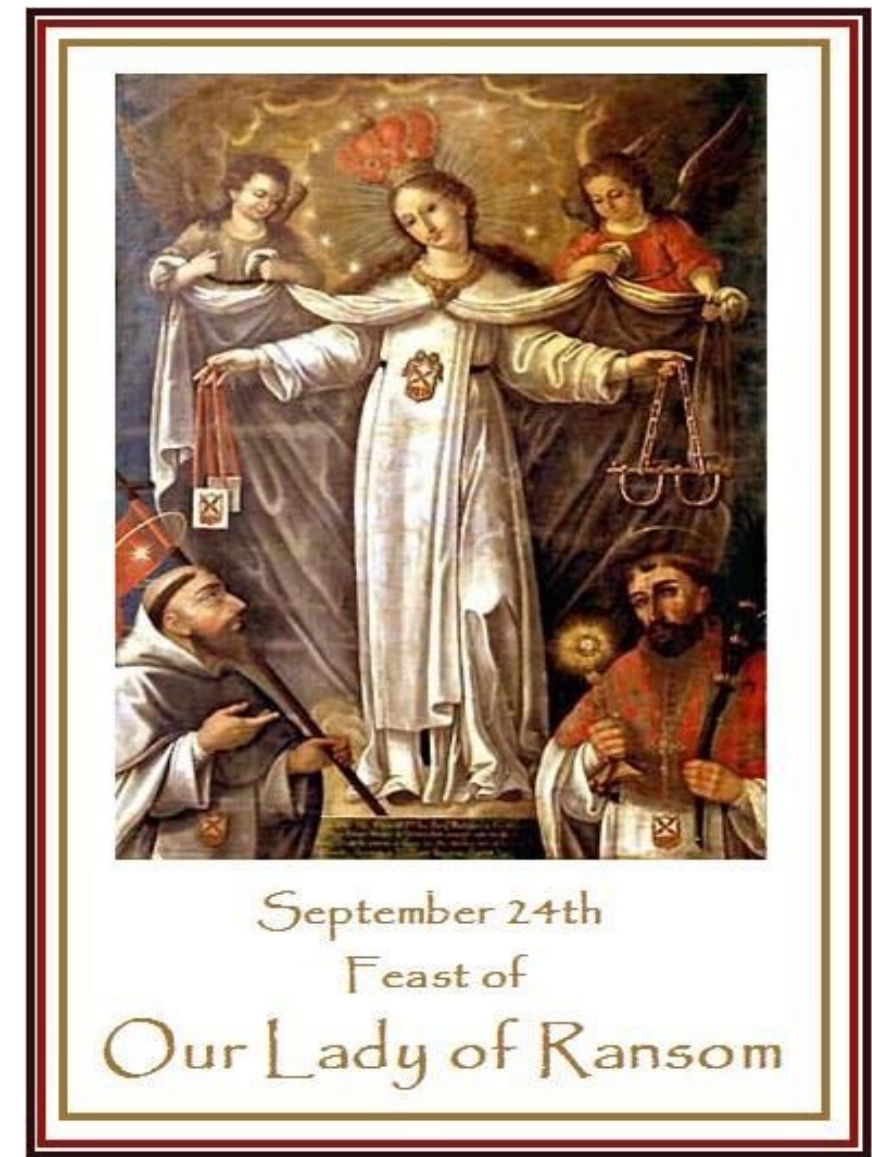
**Morning Glory Consecration Prayer**
